



- It matters! (boosting inspiration could save 5k+ lives during study period!)




Video cases

Speech (re)writing

- Re-write speech
 - Consider how you can use the tactics (for instance combine contrast with three part list or combine sentiments of collective with rhetorical question)
 - Make sure your speech starts AND finishes strong
- Compare it to the original speech. Try to enact both versions to see the difference




